





Ganesh Chaturthi

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






Janmashtami Celebration






























English Week

































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
RED COLOUR DAY

Yellow colour one more primary colour was celebrated with much enthusiasm by nursery students dressed up in the vibrant colour of yellow.




ORANGE COLOUR DAY
