## ENERGY AUDITING

Energy Auditing is a tool for identifying energy efficiency potential and measures. An energy audit is an important tool or method for finding such potentials for energy efficiency measures and for assessing their financial viability, which can be carried out at different levels. A simple level just includes a brief site inspection as well as assessing the broad energy input and output of a system – this identifies low cost energy saving opportunities.

Goals of Energy Auditing:

- Understanding how energy is used within the system or process, and where it is wasted
- Finding alternative measures to reduce energy losses and improve the overall performance

We at DHPS had organized a virtual seminar on Energy auditing for the students of Grades V- X on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2022.

It helped the students to understand that we should not waste energy and find ways to adopt energy efficient measures. And at last it can be stated that ‘ENERGY SAVED IS ENERGY GENERATED.’
