BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF DR. HOMI BHABHA



Homi Jehangir Bhabha, FRS (30 October 1909 – 24 January 1966) was an Indian nuclear physicist, founding director, and professor of physics at the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR). Colloquially known as "Father of the Indian nuclear programme" Bhabha was also the founding director of the Atomic Energy Establishment, Trombay (AEET) which is now named the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre in his honour.

The school celebrated the birth anniversary on Wednesday, 19th October 2022 Students were shown documentaries about his life and achievements.
