JUNIOR CHEF

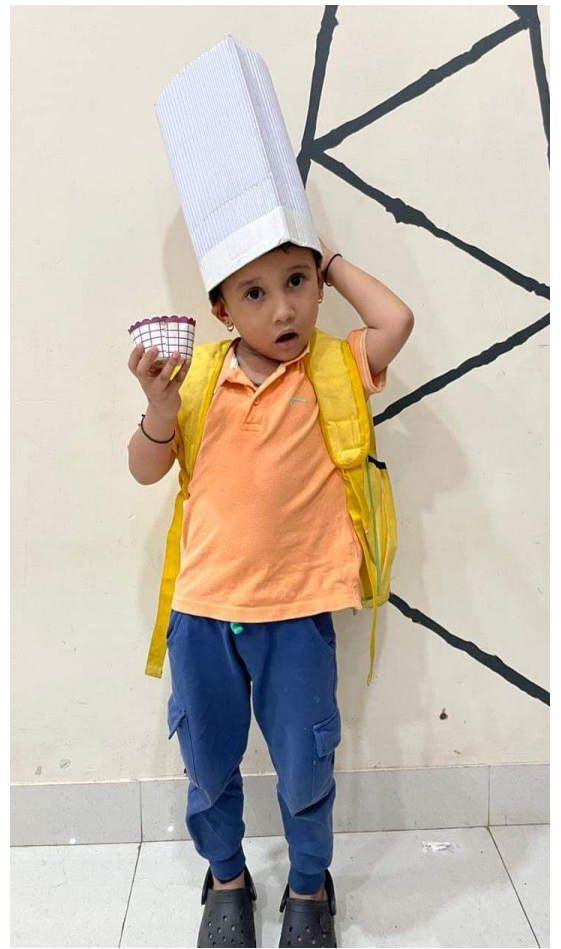
The Junior Chef program was an early technique used by the school to make young minds aware of yet another life skill, the culinary art. This activity was conducted on 19th October'2023.
